

Level Designation: Traditional* = Any student who has studied/learned Spanish only through traditional classroom study beginning at Middle/Intermediate/Junior High school or later, and who has not had any extra-classroom experience as described under “Non-Traditional.”

Non-Traditional* = Any student who has completed one or more years of an Elementary Immersion program, or whose parents speak Spanish, or who has lived in a Spanish-speaking environment for more than 1 year.
