

## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE BA DEGREE IN SPANISH

- I. A total of 128 hours, of which at least 30 hours are to be taken in residence.
- II. General Education Requirements (see University Catalog).
- III. Major Requirements and Electives: 36 credit hours total

\*At least one Spanish Linguistics course (326, 329, 421, 423, 425, 520, 521, 522, 529R) and one Spanish Literature course (440, 443R, 444, 446R, 448R, 449R, 450R, 454R, 455R, 456R, 458R, 459R, 461R) must be taken from the 18 elective hours. Spanish 490 is highly recommended for those who wish to pursue a graduate degree.
- IV. Minor or Option II:
  - A. Any minor in the university catalog is accepted, or a double major that meets the individual needs of the student.
  - B. Any student not wishing to get a formal minor, who is not certifying to teach, may complete at least 15 hours from among the following related fields (beyond the GE requirement): a second modern language (upper-division courses only), linguistics, classical civilization, Latin American History or Geography, Spanish History or Geography, Humanities, Archaeology of Spain or Latin America, Comparative Literature, Pre-med and dental, or other areas approved by the Department Chairman.
- V. Foreign Residency Requirement (see University Catalog).
- VI. Oral Proficiency - An oral proficiency exam is required for all majors with an expected score of at least three (3.0). To take this exam, students must enroll in Spanish 491.
- VII. No "D" credit is accepted toward the major.

### ***Sigma Delta Pi***

Spanish majors and minors should consider joining BYU's chapter of Sigma Delta Pi, the National Spanish Honor Society. Those students who have completed 60 hours of college credit, 18 hours of college Spanish (special credit exam hours may be counted), and either Spanish 339 or 345 (or 355), and who have a university GPA of at least 3.0 are eligible to join.
